

## **First meeting re drawing up an Energy Strategy for the village**

Actions agreed:

1. "Chidfest" happening last w/end of July in John's field – Nicky to help John in trying to get the Energy Efficiency Roadshow bus for the festival, with advice on energy audits, bulbs, etc. John to enlist Robin's help.
2. John also to talk with his daughters and see what potential there is for a youth-led campaign on energy-saving – could tie in with DOE award requirements?
3. John has done initial designs for Chidham and Hambrook Sustainability Network logo – me to take to Core Group meeting next Weds for comments ... then, try to finalise this soon so we can use it and progress with banner.
4. Seed funding – Cliff explained how FINCH got start-up funding from the Parish Council. Me to draft letter, take to Core Group, then send to Mike Penny/Barry Mann by end of June. We may need to set up bank account
5. Getting the message out via Parish newsletter .... Deadline for copy is July 14. Nicky to pull some info/tips re energy-saving/pledges together for Diana to make into article or separate insert/leaflet (which can also go to Flatt Rd, Maybush Drive etc which are in Southbourne Parish - help with delivery needed?) ... This material could also possibly go out to Church congregation ...
6. Nicky to check out supplies of Energy Saving Trust booklet and other free promotional materials, and Stephanie and I to arrange to circulate these to all members of our village network.
7. We will all keep a look-out for someone who might take on a media/communications brief for the network.
8. Tom and Douglas from Greenheart Installations (local solar and heatpump suppliers who have done quotes for Cobnor) are happy to do a presentation at an evening meeting on renewables. I'll inform the network and check out how many people are interested – then arrange date and venue as appropriate.
