

# The Parish Plan Questionnaire

Many villages throughout the country are preparing a Parish Plan. The term 'Parish Plan' here is not a religious one. It refers to the civil parish, an area defined for the purpose of local government. Part of your Council Tax is spent by the Parish Council for our local needs. The idea is to find out what changes people want to see to improve their life. To produce a Parish Plan we also need to gather facts about the village and the way we live.

This process of finding out what people want is funded by the Countryside Agency, the District Council, the Chichester Harbour Conservancy, and the Parish Council. To gather the information we need, we have produced this questionnaire.

**Each Household is to return ONE Questionnaire.**

**The Questionnaire is in two parts:**

- ❖ **The Household section should be filled in by *one* person on behalf of the household.**
- ❖ **The Personal section should be filled in by *each* person aged 11 years old or above.**

**The questionnaire is anonymous. No attempt will be made to identify individuals and their responses. All responses will be analysed collectively.**

We will let you know the results of the survey, keep you informed on progress, and any follow up actions planned.

**Please do your best to answer the questionnaire as fully as possible. It is important that as many people as possible contribute their answers. But you do not have to answer any question you don't want to.**

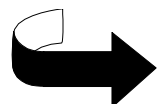
