Or: 3pm Meet at East Lavant Memorial Green for the last 6 miles to Bosham
(on lanes, so suitable for all bikes, kids etc)

**4pm Ceremony and Gathering at Bosham Quay with
re-enactment of the arrival of Irish monks in 7th century**

**Finally, at 5.30pm it's the Welcoming Party at Cobnor to celebrate
and bless the end of the 600 mile ride, the life of St Cuthman and all
the historic links etc.... Come by bike, foot or car to Cobnor and follow signs
down private lane into CAC field.**

St Cuthman grew up at Cobnor, was educated by Irish monks at Bosham, and is famous for taking his ailing mother in a wheelbarrow over the Downs to Steyning, where he founded the church. The cycle ride follows St Cuthman's route in reverse.
