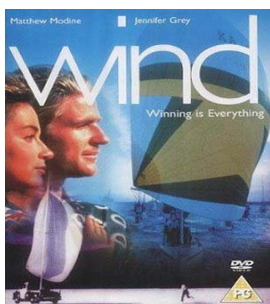


### **Friday Jan 28<sup>th</sup> JULIE & JULIA ( cert 12)**
