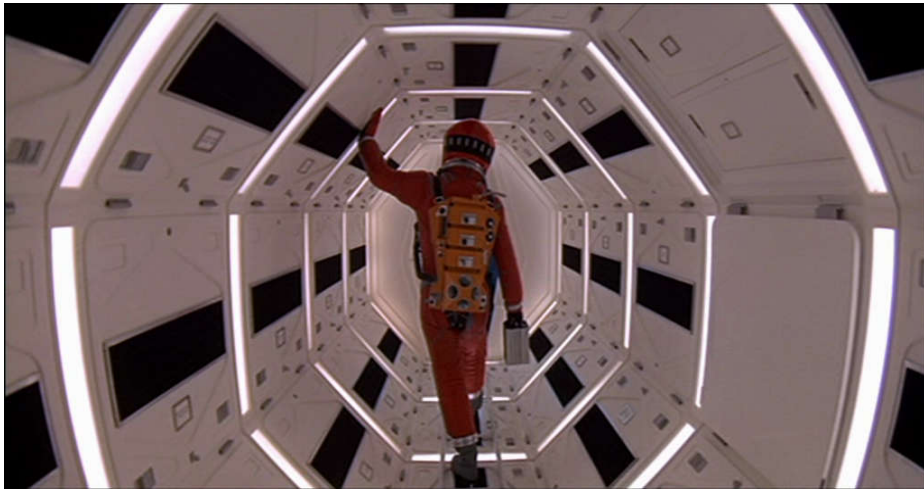

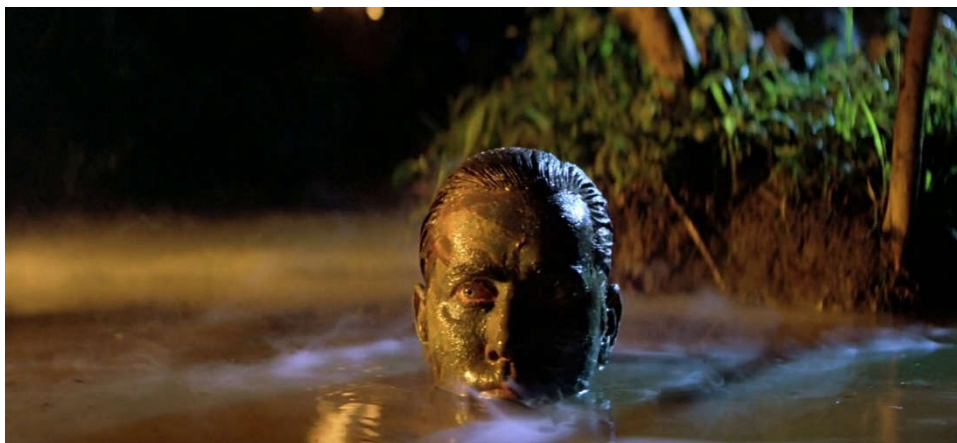


21. 1976 Only film I've seen when the whole audience jumped simultaneously!

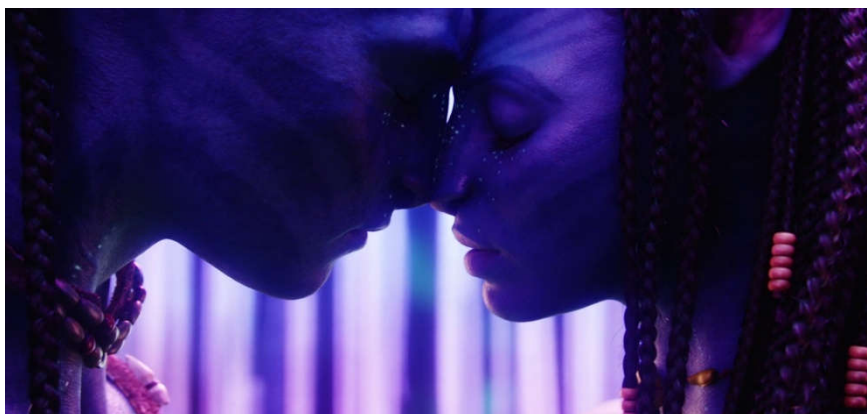
