## Update on Return to Services

We are delighted to report that our **first service will be at 0930 on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August**. Rev. Andrew Stamp will be leading the service for us. We will also be open on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> August and again on 6<sup>th</sup> September. Currently we have <u>no cover</u> for Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September but will be open again on 20<sup>th</sup> September.

Given the current restrictions, at the moment we can only safely accommodate 22 people in St Mary's and it is therefore likely that we will have to ask people to book a seat for the 23<sup>rd</sup> and possibly beyond.

More details will be sent next weekend but in the meantime here is some basic information.

- Everyone will need to wear a face covering during the service (unless of course you have a medical exemption) which will only be removed before and after taking communion.
- Although we will provide hand sanitiser you may like to bring your own bottle to use during the service when your face covering is removed/re-worn.
- There will be no collection during the service but there will be a retiring collection. We
  can provide a gift aid envelope when you arrive but you will need to bring a pen to
  complete it. Money should not be placed in the envelope but be put loosely in the
  collection receptacle with the amount you have given written on the front of the
  envelope. (You will be able to take additional envelopes home for future use).
- Only 2 persons can sit in each available pew unless of course you are visiting as a household of a greater number.
- In order to comply with the government's track and trace obligations on arrival we will need to take a name and telephone number for each household that attends. This information will be retained for 21 days.
- Churchwardens and sidespersons will guide you regarding entering the building and seating arrangements.
- There will be no singing although there will be music during the service.
- At the end of the service you will be guided to leave immediately in small groups and must not gather outside of the door or in the church grounds.
- The churchwardens will be setting up the church for the service and will be shutting everything afterwards.
