POLICY ON ENGAGING IN EARLY DISCUSSIONS ON DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

- 1. Chidham & Hambrook Parish Council welcomes early notification and detailed explanations of proposed major developments from developers or their representatives.
- 2. The developer, in seeking a meeting with the Parish Council, must provide information about the proposed development affecting the parish in writing.
- 3. The Parish Council will treat all developers fairly and equally.
- 4. The Parish Council and its councillors will make no statements or comments that can be construed as support, or otherwise.
- 5. When the Parish Council agrees to meet developers, the timing and format of such a meeting will be at the discretion of the Parish Council, and such decisions will be minuted.
- 6. The Clerk or a District Council Planning Officer shall normally make the arrangements for such a meeting, attend and write up any notes.
- 7. The meeting will be chaired by a Parish Councillor.
- 8. Any further meeting will be at the discretion of the Parish Council, and depend on new information being available.
- 9. No hospitality shall be offered by a developer and none will be accepted by any representative of the Parish Council. It is an offence for a developer or his agent to promise or give financial advantage to a local council with the expectation of an improper consideration of a planning application.
